WALK-ON FIELDS Homeside ~ Rolf ~ County ~ Wall ~ Grant Soccer/Football Fields & Baseball/Softball Fields A, B, D & T-Ball

These fields are available for walk-on use unless closed due to maintenance, marked for a game or too wet for play.

Reservations take precedence over walk-ons. MRC teams can reserve 7 days in advance, all others 2 days in advance. Youth teams may reserve two hours per week & adult teams may reserve one hour per week. The week runs Sunday - Saturday. Call 241-0363 or stop by 220 N. Walnut to make a reservation.

Light usage is \$10 per hour. You must make arrangements Monday - Friday by 5 pm and pay for light usage at the MRC Office.

LIMITED ACCESS FACILITY Grant Complex - Baseball Field C

This field is designated as a Limited Access Facility, which means access is strictly controlled by MRC.

You must have MRC's approval to use this facility. This facility is marked "No unauthorized practices allowed."

BATTING CAGES / RESTROOMS

Wall Park coin operated batting cages are open April 1st to September 30th from 7 am - Dusk.

Grant batting cages are open year around.

Wall Restrooms are open year round from 7 am - Dusk.

Grant Restrooms are open from 7 am - Dusk, except December-February.

MRC REFUND POLICY: It is the policy of the McPherson Recreation Commission to refund 80% of the unused portion of the program fee due to medical reasons or moving from McPherson County.

MRC RESERVES THE RIGHT to cancel or combine programs if necessary.

MRC NOTIFICATIONS: If field use or game status is questionable due to rain/wet fields/weather, MRC will decide at 4:30 PM on weekdays and 7:30 AM on Saturdays & decision will be posted on MRC Facebook Page.
